1 ■ Where is the Place? & Geographical Features

- Location: continent, country, and region
- Climate: temperatures, rainfall, seasons
- Mountains and highlands
- Rivers and lakes
- Beaches and coastal areas
- Deserts and arid zones
- Forests, jungles, and natural parks
- Other notable geographical features

2 ■ Animals & Places to Visit

- Interesting or unique animals that live there
- Endangered or iconic wildlife species
- Famous landmarks and monuments
- National parks and nature reserves
- Museums, galleries, and cultural sites
- Popular tourist attractions
- Hidden gems and local favourites
- Include pictures and illustrations!

3 ■ Food & Festivals

- Traditional dishes of the region
- Local drinks and beverages
- Street food and market culture
- Important festivals and annual celebrations
- Religious or historical commemorations
- Interesting cultural customs and traditions
- Music, dance, or art forms
- Dress and clothing traditions

4 ■ Transport & Travel Information

- How can tourists get there? (flights, trains...)
- Main airports, ports, or train stations
- Local transport inside the destination
- Best time of year to visit and why
- Things to pack or prepare
- Useful travel tips for tourists
- Why would YOU recommend this destination?
- Approximate travel cost or budget ideas

■ Presentation Requirements

- ■ Use **English only** throughout your poster and presentation.
- Include **pictures, maps**, and short descriptive texts.
- Be **creative** — make your poster attractive and easy to read!

■ Extra Challenge: 5-Day Itinerary

Day	Theme	Activity Idea
Day 1	Arrival & First Impressions	Arrive, check in, explore the city centre, try local food.
Day 2	Nature & Landscapes	Visit a natural park, mountain, beach, or river area.
Day 3	Culture & History	Tour museums, monuments, and historic sites.
Day 4	Food & Festivals	Take a cooking class, visit markets, attend local events.
Day 5	Hidden Gems & Departure	Explore off-the-beaten-path spots and say goodbye!
